The Juneau Chapter was represented by 18 delegates in the last biennial convention in 2006. The final calculation on the number of 2008 delegates which Juneau is entitled to will not be complete until November 15, 2007. Therefore the Chapter will be tentatively electing 18 delegates and 1 alternate, subsequent to verification of a final number by ASEA Local 52 Headquarters.

Convention delegates and alternate will be determined by nominations and subsequent vote if necessary by a quorum of Juneau Chapter members present at the regular Chapter meeting on Tuesday, October 23, 2007. Nomination forms and candidate statements (maximum one single-sided 8 ½ by 11 in. page) must be received at the Chapter mailing address by no later than Friday, October 19.

Any member in good standing may be nominated. You may nominate yourself or someone else. The Juneau Chapter policy is that you must be willing to certify in advance on the nomination form that you or the person you nominate will be present at the Convention and all Committee Work Sessions to which the delegate is assigned during the 4 day period February 21-24, 2007. Absent such certification your nomination will be unqualified.

If there are more than 19 qualified nominations, an election will be held at the regular monthly Chapter meeting on October 23, 2007. ASEA Local 52 Headquarters will confirm nominees in good standing and the Chapter Election Committee will make a determination on qualified nominations. If there are 19 or fewer nominations, the Election Committee will declare them all duly elected and no election will be held.

If an election is necessary, delegates will be determined in the order of highest to lowest vote getter. If there are fewer than 19 nominations, the nominating period will be extended and vacant seats will be filled in the order they are subsequently nominated until a full contingent is achieved. No delegate election will be held past October 23.

All primary delegate travel expenses including airfare, hotel, taxi to and from the airport, and per diem are paid for by ASEA/AFSCME Local 52. ASEA Local 52 Business Leave will also be provided for days absent from the workplace. The Juneau Chapter will finance costs for one alternate delegate. Additional alternate delegates may travel to the convention at their own expense.
